Teays Valley Development Project

Teays Valley is getting a new face-lift now that the new development, by Cathcart Properties, is set to start. Located near Teays Valley Road and the Crooked Creed Interchange of Interstate 64 and U.S. Route 35, the project will feature modern architecture with the addition of new luxury apartments, townhouses, condominiums and single-family homes.

The objective of Cathcart's development is to provide a comprehensive, luxury, master planned development that will comply with the current demand for luxury rental apartments, affordable entry-level homes and single-family homes.
